Said petition being signed twelve or more householders residing within the vicinity of said road prayed for and whereas the said J. S. Eberheart the principal petitioner has filed his bond with approved security in the sum of one hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County conditioned for the payment of all the cost arising from the view and survey of the said road, providing the prayer of the petitioners be not fully confirmed and the said road vacated and relocated; and the Board of Commissioners being satisfied that the law in the matter of the application has been fully complied with do here appoint Wm. Fordue, Dexter Tucker and John S. Williams viewers and J. C. Darling Surveyor to make the necessary view and survey and make due report of the same to the Board of Commissioners at their April term and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the necessary notices to the viewers and Surveyor and make the publication required by law.

The petitioners having asked that a part of a certain County road be vacated as follows = Commencing at the South west corner of the north west quarter of Sec 24 Township 14 Range 17 thence South on the section line to the Santa Fe road or the township road running East and West and to locate a road as follows = Commencing at the South west corner of North west $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24 of Township 14 of Range 17 = thence East on the South line of said quarter section half mile = thence South on the quarter line to the Santa Fe road or the township road line running east and west and it appearing that said vacation and re-location have been petitioned for twelve or more freeholders residing within the vicinity of the said roads and that the said principal petitioner George Thompson has filed his bond with sufficient security in the lawful sum of one hundred dollars to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County conditioned for the payment of all the costs of the survey, view and review of said vacation and re-location providing the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and the road vacated and established and the Board being satisfied that the law has in every respect been fully complied with do here with appoint H.
