Bell & James Walsh two principal petitioners have filed their bond in the sum of one hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of Douglas County - Conditioned for the payment of all the costs of the survey and view of said road providing the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and the road established. The Commissioners being satisfied that the law in the case had been fully complied with do hereby appoint T. B. Varnum Alfred Butler and John Fancett viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor to view and survey said road and make due report thereof to the next regular meeting of the Board. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue notices to the said viewers and Surveyor to meet 26th February A.D. 1877 at the place of beginning and proceed to the discharge of their respective duties.
