

in township twelve (12) of range twenty (20) in said Douglas County, and whereas the said petition is signed by twelve or more householders residing within the vicinity of said road And whereas the said Sidney Herd the principal petitioner has filed his bond with approved security for two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County Conditioned for the payment of all the costs of the view and survey of said road provided the prayer of the petition be not granted and the road established. It appearing that the law had been fully complied with in presentation of said petition the Board do hereby appoint Jacob McGeer, Edwin Zimmerman and J. H. Lewis viewers and J. C. Darling Surveyor and Command them to proceed on 24th day of February A.D. 1887 to the place of beginning and after being sworn to perform their respective duties faithfully and impartially to view & survey said road and make due report to the Board at its next regular session. And the County Clerk is ordered to issue the necessary notice to the viewers and Surveyor of the time and place of meeting.

Settlement with Trustee.

In the matter of petition by S. C. Marshall and Others for the vacation of a certain road

Marshall and others to view and report on the vacation of said road having reported in favor of said vacation which report was this day publicly read and there being no objections and the Board believing that said vacation will not be of public inconvenience, as said road has been laid for two years and not been opened do hereby grant the prayer of the petitioners and accept the report of the viewers. And the County Clerk is hereby ordered to issue in the name of the Board the necessary notice to the proper officers to cause said road to be vacated.
