Said petition was accompanied with bond as required ^{law} conditioned for the payment of all the costs and expenses incurred by said view and survey, signed by R. W. Gomell as principal and E. H. Taylor as surety; whereupon said bond was approved, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law has been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Eben Baldwin, A. B. Wade and D. G. Matt be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the place of beginning in township twelve, on the 29th day of May A.D. 1877 and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board. And the County Clerk is hereby ordered to issue notice to the viewers and County Surveyor of their appointments and cause the lawful notice to be posted and the required publication to be made.
