P. S. Simmons is damaged to the amount of thirty dollars
which we award to him.

The Commissioners had the same under consideration and
postponed final action upon the petition until the July session.
The viewers also report in favor of the vacation of a road peti-
tioned for beginning at the south west corner of the NW 1/4 of S. 24
T. 10 R. 17 because the public convenience does not demand its
continuance; it has not been opened up for travel which would be
impracticable on account of the expenditure of money and labor
it would require to make it fit for travel. Action postponed
until July Session by the Board.

In the matter of Petitioners of
J. S. Eberhart for vacation
re-location of road

The viewers to wit Wm. Parker, Dyer
Tucker and J. S. Williams appointed Jan. 1st. 1877 presented
to said County Board their several reports as follows to wit:
Pursuant to Commissioners notice we met at the place of begin-
ning designated in said petition for the vacation prayed for we had
the route surveyed as prayed for by Thos. C. Darling County Surveyor
and we would respectfully report that said road ought to be vacated
for the following reasons: The public convenience does not de-
mand its continuance and it interferes with private interests.
They further report that said road petitioned for should be vacated
for the following reasons = The public convenience will be as well
subscribed and accommodated and private interests promoted
which reports were publicly read and considered. And it appear-
ing that the law has in all respects been complied with by the
posting, serving and publication of notices and there being no
objections the reports were adopted and the road vacated as
prayed for and Established as prayed for. Forty feet 40 in
width. And it is further Ordered that the County Clerk
issue the lawful notice to the Trustees of said township to cause
said road to be vacated and the re-located road to be opened for
the public travel.
