

Duplicate order issued July 28th 1878

Alfred Lutter and John Fawcett appointed January 4th 1877 presented to the County Board their several reports as follows To wit:

Pursuant to Commissioners Notice we met at the place of beginning designated in said petition and taking to our assistance James Walsh and James B. Smith as Chaimmen and J. J. Bell as marker, proceeded to view the route of the road petitioned for, which was surveyed under our direction by Thos. C. Darling County Surveyor. The field notes and plots being part of this report and after careful deliberation we are of the opinion that said road to wit Beginning at the S.E. cor. of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec 2, T. 15 R. 20 E. Thence N. 10° E. West in line 40 chs to 1/4 cor. between secs 2 & 11. South 37 1/2 links West parallel with section line 40 chs to intersection with road running north & south; is practicable and ought to be located for the following reasons: The public convenience requires it and a good road can be made along the route surveyed at a comparatively light expenditure and with little detriment to private interests. We further determine that public convenience requires that such Co. road shall be established 30 ft (30 feet) in width. Which report was publicly read and considered. And the Commissioners being satisfied that the law has in every particular been complied with by posting, serving and publication of notice and then being no objections. D O Order the establishment of said road as prayed for. And the Co. Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the legal notice to the Township Treasurer to cause said road to be opened for the public travel. It is further ordered that Fifteen dollars 15⁰⁰ be paid to Rev Dearborn for Damages caused him by the location of said road as awarded by the Viewers

Hon. John Destines Chairman of the Board appeared in his seat at 1 P. M.
