In the matter of Petition for gates
by Thos Loy & O. P. Kennedy

The Board heard the Petitioners and remonstrants and after consideration and by agreement of parties it was Ordered that privilege be granted to the said Thos Loy and O. P. Kennedy to erect and maintain convenient gates as prayed for in the said petition until the 1st day of October A.D. 1878 when said gates shall be removed and the road so protected by gates shall be open to travel unobstructed.

In the matter of Petition of Horace E. Stone & others
for erection and maintenance of Gates

The Board heard and considered the application of H. E. Stone & others for the privilege of putting up and maintaining gates on road Ch. 13 at the intersection of Sec. 26. 34 & 35 on the main road to Yellow Springs Twp. 13. Range 19

Ordered that the privilege to erect and maintain gates as prayed for be granted two years from April 12th 1877 when said gates shall be removed and the road opened to travel unobstructed.

In the matter of Suit of David Martin
vs. Comm. for Damages in A. Walter Road Co.

Ordered that sixty five dollars be appropriated for the use of David Martin as a compromise of said suit Mer Martin agreeing to withdraw the same and pay the costs.

Ordered That Theodore Pocher and R. C. Taster be and are hereby appointed to assist the Probate Judge in counting the funds in the Office of the County Treasurer.
