

line between sections three (3) in township fourteen (14) and section thirty four (34) in township thirteen (13) of range twenty (20) - thence north through the center of sections thirty four (34) and twenty seven (27) to the quarter section stone on the line between sections twenty two (22) and twenty seven (27) in said township thirteen (13) of range twenty as recorded on page 132 of Book "A" of the Record of roads in said county; that said road has never been opened and in as much as there are public roads opened upon the lines of said sections parallel with and but half a mile distant on either side of said road, there is no necessity for a public road through said sections and furthermore that there is standing a full ^{and complete} grove, hedge fence on a considerable portion of said line; therefore we pray that said above described location of a road be vacated as provided by law. Said petition was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by Thos. D. Smith as principal and J. H. Melly, McRidgdon and W. L. Tuttle as sureties in the penal sum of one hundred dollars; whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Henry Sandons, Thos. H. Jones & Elijah Elam be appointed viewers of the proposed vacation and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the 1st day of June A.D. 1877 and proceed to discharge the duties of their several appointments, giving all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board. And the Co. Clerk is instructed to give the necessary notices to the viewers and surveyor and make the legal publication required.

Be it Remembered that on this the 13th day of April A.D. 1877 a road petition signed by Thos. R. Benson and others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas praying for the location of a certain road described as follows To wit Beginning at the North East Corner of north east quarter of section fourteen (14) Township fourteen (14) Range Seventeen (17) thence west on the section line between sections fourteen and eleven (14 & 11) one mile to the west line of the County.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Thos. R. Benson as principal and Henry Hiatt and Gustav A. Santer as sureties, in the penal
