

Commencing at the Johnson County line between sections three and ten (3440) Township fifteen (15) Range twenty one (21) from there running west on the section line one and a half miles terminating on the half section line of sections four and nine (449) connecting there with the Myandotte and Council Grove territorial road;

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law; signed by J. H. Baker as principal and Alvin Tim as surety in the penal sum of one hundred dollars conditioned for the payment of all the cost of the view & survey provided said petition should not be granted by the Board; Said Bond was approved by the Board it appearing to the satisfaction of the Commissioners that the law had been substantially complied with; it was ordered that John Dancett, W. L. Campbell and J. J. Bell be appointed viewers and Thos. C. Darling surveyor and that they meet at the place of beginning on the 31st day of May A.D. 1877 and proceed to view and layout said road according to law giving all parties a hearing and make due report of the same to the County Board. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed give notice to the viewers and surveyor of their several appointment and to cause to be published & posted the legal notice.
