The Commissioners Record from January 1st A.D. 1877 to and including April 18th 1877 was read, corrected and approved and ordered signed by the Chairman of the Board and sealed by the County Clerk which was accordingly done.

In the matter of Petition of Jas. Holling and John Noacker for discharge from confinement in Co. jail: the Board had the same under consideration when it appeared that they had served out the time for which they were sentenced, and had no money to pay the fine assessed or property out of which it could be made. The Board ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to notify the Sheriff to discharge said Holling and Noacker from Jail.
