

Consideration the petition of J. R. Topping and others for the location of a road as follows: One mile on the section line between Sections Thirty one (31) and Sections Thirty two (32) Township twelve (12) Range nineteen (19) in Douglas County Kansas connecting the road running north from the Wakarusa creek with the California road at the north east corner of Section Thirty one (31) of township and range aforesaid.

It appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders residents of Douglas County, and that said petitioner had filed his bond conditioned for the payment of all the costs of view, survey, and other cost attending the service of said petition providing the prayer of the petitioner should not be finally granted and confirmed the Board hereby appoints Wm. Place S. Winters and R. Richards viewers and Thos. C. Darling Surveyor of said whose duty it shall be to proceed to the place of beginning on the Seventh (7th) day of Sept. A.D. 1877 and after being duly sworn to perform their respective duties faithfully and impartially to view & survey said proposed road and make due report to the next regular sitting of the Board. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue notice to the viewers & surveyors of their several appointments and make the required lawful publication of these proceedings.

In the matter of Petition of John Speraw
+ others for the Location of a road

Beginning on the North line of the north west quarter of section seven (7) Township thirteen (13) Range twenty (20) where Massachusetts street in the city of Lawrence extended South would intersect said section line, thence running South as near as practicable to near the North bank of the Wakarusa river thence across said river at the most practicable point, thence to the half section line between the East and West halves of section nineteen (19) township thirteen (13) Range twenty (20) thence South on said half section line to the South line of the north half of Sections thirty (30) Range twenty (20) Township thirteen (13):

It appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders citizens of Douglas County and a good sufficient bond payable to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County conditioned for the payment of all the costs attending said view & survey in case the prayer of the petitioners should not be granted: We therefore do appoint J. L. Jones, J. C. Vincent and D. O. Benjamin, three disinterested persons as viewers and Thos. C. Darling, Surveyor who shall meet at the place of beginning on the 31st day of August A.D. 1877 and after being duly sworn to perform their several duties faithfully and impartially to proceed to view & survey
