

In the matter of Cancellation of Tax deed
Sought for by James Blood

Samuel A. Riggs esq. attorney for James Blood tendered a tax deed for Cancellation, to the N W 1/4 of Sec 23. T. 14 R. 17. and asked the Board to name some person to whom the said Blood should execute a Quit claim deed on the ground that the taxes on said land for which it was sold were paid prior to date of sale. The Board had the same under consideration and postponed final action until some future day.

Postponed from last session until this term. The Board had the same under consideration and rejected the prayer of the petitioners for the reasons: the road did not seem to be a necessity for public travel and the damages claimed and proven could not be paid by the county.

the vacation of a certain road
by T. B. Smith & others

The viewers appointed at the April term (see page 35 of this record) made report which was this day publicly read which set forth that they had discharged the duties of their appointment and report in favor of granting the prayer of the petitioners for the reasons "public convenience does not demand the continuance of said road, there being a road parallel to it on the west and will be on the east only 1/2 mile from it in either direction." The Board having the same under consideration and there being no objections filed to the granting of the said vacation: it was ordered that the prayer of the petitioners be granted and said road vacated. And the Co. Clerk instructed to make due record of the same on the Road record of Douglas County.
