

the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility convenience and inconvenience, and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public by the location of said road as shown by the Field notes and Plat of the Survey hereto attached.

We would respectfully report that the said road ought to be established for the following reasons: Public Convenience demands it and it is naturally a good route for a road which can be made fit for travel at a trifling expenditure of labor and money.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established (40) forty feet in width. Signed McE McMillen & J. P. Glesser which report was this day publicly read and there being no objections and the Board being satisfied that the law had in all respects been complied with. Do hereby grant the prayer of the petitioner and order the road established as prayed for. And the Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the notice to the Township Trustee for the lawful opening of the same.

The report of the viewers was again read and carefully considered whereupon the Commissioners being fully satisfied that said petition was signed by twelve householders residing within the vicinity of said road; that said petitioner had neither egress or ingress without the laying of said private road, and that no inconvenience resulted to any other person by granting the prayer of the petitioner, and being fully satisfied the law has in every respect been complied with.
