The viewers appointed April 14th 1877
Supra page 41 of this record made report which was this day publicly read as follows: "In obedience to your order issued at your April Session A.D. 1877 we the viewers appointed under said order met with J. C. Darling Surveyor at the place designated on the 31st day of May 1877 and were severally sworn to discharge faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order. W. H. S. Bell and S. F. Lee were selected by us as chain carriers and J. H. Baker as marker, who were also duly sworn. We then proceeded to view said proposed County road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public by the location of said roads as shown by the Field notes and Plat of the survey accompanying our report. And we would respectfully report that the said road ought to be located for the following reasons. The public convenience demands it.

We also determine that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established 50 feet in width.

The Commissioners having said report under consideration and being satisfied that said petition was signed by a least twelve householders and that the public travel requires the establishment of the road and that the law has in all respects been complied with and there being no objections. We hereby accept the report of the viewers and grant the prayer of the petitioners and order the road as viewed to be established. And the Co. Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the necessary papers to the Township Trustee for the opening of the same.
