

Lawrence Douglas Co. Kansas (September 11th 1877)

The Board of Commissioners met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to the requirements of law to canvass the votes cast at the special election held Sept 4th 1877 on the proposition to compromise certain rail road bonds. There were present Geo W. Cady John D. Stevenson and John Waller the Co. Clerk D. D. Diggs. The votes were canvassed.

The following is an abstract of votes cast at the special election held in the several voting precincts of Douglas County State of Kansas on the 4th day of September A.D. 1877 on a proposition to compromise the railroad bond indebtedness of said county at fifty per cent of the whole amount of indebtedness.
