

Lawrence Douglas County Kansas October 3rd A.D. 1877.

The Board of Commissioners met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners Deshines, Walton & Cody and Co. Clerk Diggs.

In the matter of Petition by Henry Heath
for the vacation of certain portion of Pine
Mound in Marion Township.

Said petition being under consideration and it appearing that publication had been made according to law and legal notice thereby given and this being the day set for the hearing of the same No person being present to object to said vacation as petitioned for His Honor Ordered that the prayer of the Petitioner be granted and that all the streets and alleys in Pine Mound Marion Township Douglas Co. Kansas are hereby vacated except those on which public roads are located and except also the streets and alleys running through and bounding the following described blocks To wit lots 7, 14, 15, 21, 22, 23, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to notify the Register of Deeds of this action of the Board that he may note said vacation on the plat of said Pine Mound.

In the matter of damages claimed
By Mr. Mitchell on the road petitioned
for by Mr. Stump and others and located October 12th 1869.
The Commissioners having the same under consideration it was
Ordered that twenty seven dollars and fifty 27.50 be appropriate
and paid to Mr. Mitchell in final and full settlement of all damages
on account of the laying of said road.

The Board adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 O'clock A.M.
