Kansas are hereby vacated except those on which public roads are located and except also the streets and alleys running through and bounding the following described blocks To W. 14. 15. 21. 22. 23. 30. 31. 32. 33. 34. and 35. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to notify the the Register of Deeds of this action of the Board that he may note said vacation on the plat of said Twin Mound.

In the matter of Damages claimed }

for by Wm Stump and others and located October 12th 1867.

The Commissioners having the same under consideration it was Ordered that twenty seven dollars and fifty 27.50 be appropriated and paid to Wm Mitchell in final and full settlement of all damages on account of the laying of said road.
