

corner of Section thirty one (31) in Township Twelve (12) Range nineteen (19) in Douglas Co Kansas and running due north on or near the section line between said section thirty one and Sec. thirty two in said Township on the California road will be of public utility completing a road from Wakarusa creek to the California road and also to the Kansas river.

And now comes the Viewers appointed at the July session see page 58 of this record and make report that they proceeded to view said proposed county road on the line described in your order and causes the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at reasonable expense taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public by the location of said road as shown by the field notes and plat of the Surveyor filed with this report. And we respectfully report that the said road ought to be established for the following reasons =

"The public convenience demands it and a good road can be made along the route surveyed at a trifling expenditure of money and labor. We also have determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established 40 feet in width.

We further find that Mary M. McLelland will be damaged sixty five dollars by the location of said road and have allowed said amount of damages.

The foregoing report having been read in the hearing of the Commissioners and the same being under consideration, and it appearing that the law had in all respects been complied with and there being no objections it was ordered that said road be established as prayed for and that the County be instructed to issue the necessary papers for the opening of the same and make the proper entries in the Roadbook in his office.

In the matter of Petition for a road by Elias W. Rake and others 3

Said petitioners prayed for the location of a road by consent of parties interested, and without Viewers and Surveyors. And the Board having set this day for the hearing of said petitioners have had the same under consideration and find that there are remonstrants against the location of said road and therefore reject the prayer of the petitioners because the law has not been fully complied with as in such cases made and provided.

In the matter of a change of road 33
Petitioned for by James H. Ransom and others 33 That you will change the road leading from Clinton to Ecompton at a point where it crosses the Wakarusa running up the Creek in a N.E. direction on north side of the creek until it reaches the quarter line thence north about sixty rods more or less until it intersects the road
