

N 145 ch. 1/2 intersection with old road on Sec. line - Said road ought to be relocated for the following reasons. The road of which this will form a part being a very important one and a bridge being indispensable at the crossing of Capt. Creek it can be made at a much less cost than on the old line. Public Convenience requires that such relocation shall be established 55 feet in width the same as the old road.

The Board having said reports under consideration and being satisfied that the law had in all respects been complied with and there being no objection the reports were adopted and the prayers of the petitioners granted. And the County Clerk instructed to make the entry of the vacation and relocation of said road in the Road Records of his office - and issue the necessary papers for the vacation and relocation of the same.

In the matter of the George Thompson Road laid over July 11th 77 page 75.

The Board had the petition for this road under consideration but in order to gain additional information as to its utility and damage to certain parties they further action was postponed until the January session of the Board.
