In the matter of the vacation and re-location of a certain road petitioned for by Martin Drake and others

The viewers appointed at the July session see page 65 of this Record, having made report which was read to the Board as follows. In obedience to your order at your July session 1877 your viewers appointed under said order met with J. C. Darling Co. Surveyor at the place designated on Aug 31 & Sept 28-77 and were severally sworn to discharge faithfully and impartially the duties required in said order and E. W. Martin & M. C. Burlingame were chosen chain carriers and J. M. Shepherd a marker who were also duly sworn. We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same, as in our opinion, a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility convenience and inconvenience and expense, which will result to individuals as well as the public by the Location of said road, as shown by the Field Notes and Plat of the Surveyor filed herewith. And now would respectfully report that the said Road ought to be established for the following reasons. The public Convenience demands it. We have also determined that the public Convenience requires that such road shall be established 40 feet in width. On the outside of the foregoing report of the viewers they have made the following inclosure. The conditions of granting the vacation petition and location of road of Martin Drake give right of way for road on the north line of S.E. 1/4 Sec 15, Town 19, Range 19. On the petition to vacate a Co. road on the line described in your orders and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition taking into consideration, the utility, convenience and
