The Board of Commissioners met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Diskins, Cady & Wallen & the County Clerk B. G. Griff

The viewers appointed at  
the April session of the Board that they met with J. C. Darling  
Co Surveyor at the place designated on the 5th day of June 77 and were  
severally sworn to discharge faithfully and impartially the duties  
required and that A. B. Lott and J. P. Sawyer were selected by them as  
chain carriers and L. H. Frazer as a marker who were also duly  
sworn The viewer proceeded to view said proposed County road  
on the line described in your order and caused the same to be surveyed  
as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion  
a good road can be made at a reasonable expense taking into con-  
sideration utility convenience and inconvenience and expense which  
will result to individuals as well as the public by the location of  
said road as shown by the Field Notes and Plat of the Surveyor  
herein filed a Recd - 14 M E Compt of Recd 14 Tom 11 Page

Begin at the N.E. corner of sec 14 Town 14, Range 17 E thence Va. 10° E. West between Secs 11 and 14 37  $\frac{35}{6}$  chs to  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner West in line 37  $\frac{35}{6}$  chs the corner 15 10.11.14 & 15 of said town & range. We respectfully report that said road ought to be established for the following reasons Public convenience demands it and a good road can be made at a trifling expenditure of labor and money.
