

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such road shall be established 40 feet in width.

The Board had the report of the viewers under consideration and believing the law had been in all respects ^{been} complied with and there being no objections and believing that the road will be of public utility the report of the viewers is accepted and the road as petitioned for Ordered established and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to make record of the same on the Road Record in his office and issue the necessary legal orders for the opening of the same.

Beginning at the North East Corner of Section 5 Town 14 S R. 21 E. And run that one half mile to the North West Corner of N.E. 1/4 of said Sec 5 Also to change and relocate a part of County road as follows Beginning at a point about 20 rods west of the North West Corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec 5 T. 14 R. 21 E. Thence in a South westerly direction about 15 rods, thence west across Little Wakarusa about 6 rods, thence in a North Westerly direction to intersection with road as now located.

The Board having the same under consideration and being satisfied that said ^{petition} is signed by at least twelve householders residents of Douglas Co. And the principal petitioner having filed his bond with approved security in the lawful sum of Seventy five (\$75) dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County Conditioned for the payment of all the cost that shall in any way accrue upon said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners shall not be granted, or in case the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not finally be confirmed and established Now therefore it is Ordered that J. B. Smith, Daniel Gammert, William Tuttle, and the County Surveyor be appointed to view and survey said road prayed, and they are hereby instructed to proceed to the place of beginning on the day of and after choosing competent Chairmen and a marker and after and after being duly sworn each to discharge his duties faithfully and impartially to view & come to survey said proposed road and make report in writing to the Board of your opinion in favor or against granting the prayer of the petitioners. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the legal notice to the Viewers & Surveyor of their appointments, and time and place of meeting.
