

In the matter of a Petition for
the Establishment of a road

The viewers appointed at the July session of the Board see page sixty six of this Record make the following report, which was publicly read. That in obedience to the Order issued by the Board at its July session 1877 with these viewers appointed under said order met with John Darling County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the proposed road and were severally sworn to discharge faithfully and impartially the duties required in said order. He selected E. H. Avery and Charles Darling as Chain carriers and Herbert J. Landon as a marker who were also duly sworn. He then proceeded to view said proposed road on the line described in your order and caused the same to be surveyed "as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience and expense, which will result to individuals as well as the public by the Location of said road as shown by the Field Notes and Plat of the Surveyor filed herewith.

And we would respectfully report that the said Road ought to be established for the following reasons. Said road is at present and has been for many years open and used by the public as a road of travel and is necessary for the public convenience.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Road shall be established sixty 60 feet in width.

The Board having the foregoing report under consideration and believing that the law has in all respects been complied with and that the road petitioned for will be of public utility and there being no objections or damages claimed. Do hereby Order the Establishment of said road as petitioned and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to make entry of the same on the Road Records of his Office and issue the legal papers for the opening of the same.
