William Leggett & Wife One dollar a week each (\$1.00)

Mrs. Lill One dollar and fifty cents a week (1.50)

Mrs. Marion and three children Two dollars (\$2.00) a week for all.

Mrs. Cowart One dollar and fifty cents (1.50) a week

J. Busman and Wife Fifty cents each a week (50¢)

Two children in the care of J. Bell One dollar each (\$1.00)

Wm. Harris & Wife One dollar Each

Mr. Sperry appeared before the Board and asked that the further consideration of the matter be postponed until the next regular term which request was considered and granted.

change of width of road to 21 ft 33

from 60 to 21 ft in width 33

The same being under consideration the County Clerk was instructed to advertise and publicly make known said application for change in the width of said road and set the hearing of the same for the April Term. Said road was established May 7th 1873
