Lawrence Douglas County Kansas February 27th A.D. 1878

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co. met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment on the 22d. There were present John Walton & John C. Walton and the Chairman John Destines & Clerk B. J. Diggs

In pursuance of an invitation of J. G. Waters attorney for the Atchinson Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad Company was present for the purpose of making a proposition for the settlement of the tax, levied on the property of the St. Louis Lawrence and Western Railroad for the years of 1874, 1875 & 1876. The same being under consideration the following was agreed upon as a basis of settlement

In the matter of the Taxes for 1874, 1875, 1876 levied on the property of the St. Louis, Lawrence and Western Railroad Company, purchased by Frank Morrison at the Mortgage sale of said road

The said Frank Morrison for himself and those he represents has offered to pay to the Treasurer of Douglas in full payment and complete satisfaction of all taxes of every kind and nature levied on that particular portion of the property of the Saint Louis Lawrence and Western Railroad Company in said County of Douglas purchased by the said Frank Morrison at the sale of said property under foreclosure and being situate in and from the City of Lawrence to the east line of the County of Douglas levied for
