The sum of Twenty five hundred dollars (\$2,500) within ten days from February 27th 1878 and which offer having been considered by the Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of Douglas is hereby accepted and the Treasurer of said County of Douglas is hereby directed and ordered to receive said sum in accordance with said offer and to execute his receipt upon such payment according to the terms of this order. Provided however that this payment and the proceedings had thereon shall in no wise affect or prejudice any tax or sale thereunder levied or made on the property of said St Louis Lumber and Western Railroad Company not purchased by the said Frank Morrison, and this order and agreement as executed by the said Board of County Commissioners and the said Frank Morrison shall be entered on the proceedings of said Board as of its session held this 27th day of February 1878
