The Board being satisfied that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders, citizens of Douglas County residing within near the vicinity of said road and the Principal petitioner having filed his bond with approved security payable into the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas Co. conditioned for the payment of all the costs that may arise from the view and survey of said road in case the prayer of the petitioner is not finally granted. Do hereby appoint Thaddeus Wheldon W. B. Kennedy & George C. Brackett Viewers of proposed road and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and direct them to proceed on the 28th day of May 1878 at the place above designated as the beginning of said proposed road and after taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments take to your assistance two suitable persons as chain carriers and one marker and proceed to survey & locate said road as prayed for in the said petition, or as nearly so as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense taking into consideration the utility convenience and convenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue notices to Viewers and Surveyors of their several appointments and of the time and place of meeting in the name of the Board. The Viewers are directed to make report of their proceedings at the next Regular meeting of the Board. The Board adjourned until tomorrow morning 9 o'clock A.M.
