for the location of a road

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Commencing at the South west Corner of Section 28 Township 14 Range 20 running due East on the Section line between Section Twenty Eight and Thirty three in Palmyra Township: the same being two hundred rods more or less, being a Continuance of a road running East from Hollow Springs Township the same to intersect a road running through North East quarter of Section (33) in Palmyra Township the same being a road petitioned for by W. Barricklow and others And whereas the Commissioners being satisfied that the said is signed by at least twelve householders residing in Douglas County and near the vicinity of said road and the petitioners having filed a good sufficient bond payable to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County Conditions for the payment of all the costs of the view and survey of said proposed road providing the prayer of the petitioners shall not be granted. Do hereby appoint Andrew Douglas, J. M. Melley and Oscar Burroughs viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said proposed road and they are hereby instructed to meet at the place of beginning of the 3rd day of June A.D. 1878 and after taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of your appointments take to your assistance two suitable persons as chairman and one marker and proceed to view, survey and locate said road as prayed for in said petition or as nearly so as in your opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as to the public and make due report of the same to this Board at the July Session 1878 And the Co-Clerk is hereby instructed to issue notices to the Viewers and Surveyor of their several appointments and time and place of meeting.
