Mr. Spraw and Dr. Lamm appeared for the Petitioners and Dr. George Leary for the Remonstrants. After listening to the presentation of the case from both sides at the request of Commissioner John C. Walton, who desired further information on the route of the road proposed to be located the final hearing of the case was laid over until the July term of the Commissioners.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter Section two (2) Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18) and running west on said line two hundred yds (200). thence North three hundred and sixty (360) feet on Jones Street in the City of Leocompton. thence West on Sixth Street Eight hundred and thirty one (831) feet thence north Sixty feet (60) thence West on the north side of Chas. Bartlett's fence eleven hundred and seventy four feet (1174 ft) to Elmira Street, thence South three hundred feet (300) to a A. A. Sellers north line thence West on the north side of Sellers fence Six hundred and eighty six feet to whetfield street, the Commissioners and where as the Commissioners being satisfied that said petition was signed by at least twelve house holders residing in Douglas Co. Kansas and the said D. B. Day the principal petitioner having filed a good and sufficient bond conditioned for the payment of all the costs accruing from the view & survey of said road providing the prayer of the petitioners be not granted Do hereby appoint A. H. Buck Francis Walter and Geo. W. Umbarger Viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor of said road and that you
