Office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment. There  
were present John C. Day, John Walter & Dr. Lester, Chairman of the

*Location of Road 33* The petition of Mr. Serry for  
the location of a certain road which was postponed at the January  
Session until this day, came up for hearing and consideration.  
Mr. Sparav and Dr. Sauer appeared for the Petitioners and  
Dr. George Leary for the Respondents. After listening to  
the presentation of the case from both sides at the request of  
Commissioner John C. Walton, who desired further information  
on the route of the road proposed to be located the final hearing  
of the case was laid over until the July term of the Commissioners.

*Location of a certain County 33*  
*Road by D.B. Day and others 33*

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter section two (2) Township twelve (12),  
Range Eighteen (18) and running west on said line two hundred  
yards (200). thence North three hundred and Sixty (360) feet on  
Jones Street in the City of Leavenworth, thence West on Sixth street  
Eight hundred and thirty one (831) feet thence north Sixty feet  
(60) thence West on the north side of A. B. Bartlett fence  
eleven hundred and forty four feet (1174ft) to Elmira street, thence  
South Two hundred feet (200) to a A. S. Sellers north line thence  
West on the north side of Sellers fence Six hundred and  
eighty six feet to Whifield street, the terminus and whereas the  
Commissioners being satisfied that said petition was signed  
by at least twelve house holders residing in Douglas Co. Kansas and  
the said D.B. Day the principal petitioner having filed a good
