The Board Organized as a Board of Equalization under the requirement of Law Sect. 73 and 74 Laws of 1876.

The County Clerk laid before the Board the corrected return of the several Townships of the county and the City of Laurence.

In the matter of
C. J. Anderson application for reduction in the assessment of a Mortgage in Clinton Township, P. A. Golbe was sworn and testified that value of the Mortgage to be Twelve hundred dollars (\$12.00). Thereupon the assessment was ordered reduced from 2.00 to 12.00. The personal property assessment roll of Mann Township claimed the attention of the Board until it adjourned until to morrow morning June 10th 1878.
