Pesh and others and thence four rods north of the South line of the Nth of Section Thirty (30) Township Clinton Range Twenty being the land owned by Peter Kallston pro and unless the Damages claimed by Peter Kallston shall by the Petitioners be compromised at \$1000 the H. Kennedy at \$250 (250) Mary Blanton at Fifty (15) appt of Blanton at Forty (\$40) by the 1st of October said Petition will be considered as rejected.
