Road Laid over from the Street to the same coming up for consideration and the parties in interest having had a hearing it was ordered that said road be established as follows for commencing on the north Bank of the Wakarusa River thence across said river at the most practicable point hence to the 8th S<sup>t</sup> line between the East and West lines of Section 19, Town 13 Range 20 thence South on said 8th line of the 11th of Sec 30, Township 13 Range Twenty (20) thence to join a road located April 15th 1875 on the petition of A. Posh and others and thence four rods north of the South line of the 11th of Section Thirty (30) Township Nineteen Range Twenty being the land owned by Peter Ralston pro ans unless the damages claimed by Peter Ralston shall by the Petitioners be compromised at \$100 or Sh. H. Kennedy at \$ Fifty (\$50) Mary Blanton at Fifty (\$50) agent of Sutton at Forty (\$40) by the 1st of October said petition will be considered as rejected.
