

Lawrence Douglas Co Kansas July 6th A.D. 1878

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment. There were present John Astens, John Walton & H. Walton and Co. Clerk B. F. Diggs.

In the matter of a road Petition
for by H. R. Sorman.

The Board had under consideration a petition for a Public road petitioned for by H. R. Sorman and others Beginning on the Range line between Range Eighteen and nineteen (18 & 19) at the corner to Sections 14, 24, 25 and 30 Township 14 South and running thence south on said range line Two (2) miles more or less to the SE corner of Section 36 Town 14 Range 18 E.

The petitioner presented a written statement of consent from all the parties owning land along the line of the road prayed and relinquishing all claim to damage in consequence of the location of said road which statement is on file with said petition whereupon the Board ordered the road as petitioned for established and directed the County Clerk to issue the necessary order for the legal opening of the same.

In the matter of J. R. Studabaker and others
Petition for privilege of erecting gates. The following petition was read and considered by the Board

We the undersigned desiring to grow a hedge would respectfully ask permission to erect gate on a new road ordered opened One gate about 100 rods north of the intersection of the section lines between sections 9, 4, 9 and 10 Town 15 Range 18 and another about 80 rods north of the same point

Accompanying said petition was the written consent of the Householders on the line of the "new road" to the erection of the gates asked for. Whereupon the Board ordered that the privilege of erecting and maintaining the gates prayed for be and is hereby granted.
