attorney for Plaintiff filed the following petition

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co
Kansas

Your petitioner the Laconia Savings Bank respectfully re-
sents that it has purchased at Sheriff's sale the North 117th part of Lot 1 and
12 in Block 4 Babcock's addition to the city of Lawrence and now
offers to redeem the same from the Lien of all Taxe imposed to said property
for the years 1873-1874-1875 and 1876 for State County and Township purpose
and for School District purposes for the year 1875

2 Your petitioner further represents that for the years 1873 1874, and
1876 Taxes were assessed to said property for city, city school and special road
purposes all of which are claimed by your petitioner to be illegal and void
not a valid charge against said property and application will be
made at an early date to the Mayor and Council of the City of Lawrence for
a relinquishment of all claim by said City to said taxe.

3 Your petitioner further represents that application was made to the
Treasurer of Douglas County on May 3d 1878 to redeem said property
from the Lien of all Taxe mentioned in the first paragraph of this
petition and the full amount of said taxes, penalties, cost and interest
was tendered but the said Treasurer refused to certify to certify such
redemption or to receive the money tendered therefor

4 Your petitioner further represents that said property has
been sold for all the Taxe levied as aforesaid to the said County
that no part of said Taxe have been redeemed by any person
nor has said County sold or assigned the certificate of sale
