and then and there exhibit your books and accounts making a
full correct and complete showing of all money received by
you from whatever source they may have been derived and
at such time and place the Board desires to make and complete
such a settlement of the financial affairs of each city, town, town-
ship, school district or other municipal organization as the
regulating the duties of County Treasurers requires and provides
for and that at such time and place you will file in
the Office of the County Clerk all receipts and vouchers for
any and all money paid out by you during your said
term of office
