Watson had a consultation with the Board and asked that if Mr. Watson
turned over his vouchers to the Board that the County should not com-
mence suit against him until the expiration of thirty days from the
date of his resignation which was agreed to. Unless the City commence
suit then the County shall be at liberty to join the City in the
prosecution at once. Mr. J. C. Walker refused to make any stipula-
tions. Mr. Watson through his attorney Mr. Barker agreed to
commence settlement Monday July 22d. To which time the Board
adjourned
