Watson. There were present John Deskins, John Walton & H. B. Dipp. Co. Clerk. Mr. Watson presented vouchers from School District Nos. 26, 27, 28-29, 30-31-32-33-34-35 \$36 amounting to Five thousand six hundred and eighty and forty nine cent, - \$5682.49 which were examined and found correct.
