Ordered by the Board That a levy of Ten (10) mills on the dollar on all the taxable property in School District No 84 be and is hereby made for interest and sinking fund

Ordered by the Board that a levy of Twelve (12) mills on the dollar on all the taxable property in School District No 85 be and is hereby made for interest and sinking fund

The Board having completed the levy of all taxes required by the Law to be made adjourned sine die
