

Laurence Kansas Douglas County. October 10th A.D. 1879

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co met in the Office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment then were present John Deskins John C. Walton and John Walton & Septy to Clerk A. P. Brooks

In the matter of Petition of William R. Anderson for the Location of a certain road laid over from last Session. The report of the Viewers was taken up and Evidence was taken for and against the location of the road when it was finally agreed by consent of all parties interested to drop all proceedings had under the former petition and that the Board proceed to appoint new Viewers and that a re-survey of the proposed road be made whereupon the Board appointed Edwin Zimmerman man Andrew Douglas and L. J. Sperry said Viewers who were charged with duty of making a new view and to report at the next Regular Session of this Board

In the matter of a petition for a road by W. S. Pennington rather the Board had the same under consideration. The Viewers appointed July 6th 1878 on the Petition of W. S. Pennington and others made report that on the 23rd of August 1878 they proceeded to the place designated and proceeded to view said road on the line described in your order and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense taking into consideration the utility, convenience, inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as to public by the location of said road as shown by field note and plot of the survey books attached. We respectfully report said road ought to be established for the reason the public convenience requires it and a good road can be made on the route surveyed at a trifling expense of labor and money said to be established 100 feet in width.
