

Laurence Kansas Douglas Co. October 11th 1878

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas met in the office of the County Clerk, pursuant to adjournment. There were present John Destines, John Walton, J. L. Walton & Septylee Clark A. G. Brooks

In the matter of Petition of W. S. Punnington for location of a road ³³ The Board had the same under consideration and its further consideration was postponed until the January session of the Board

In the matter of the Road ³³ Petition of Wm. C. Gill & others ³³ Men. Alexander Odell having filed his acceptance of the award of the Commissioners to him in case the said road was established which completes the conditions required by the Commissioners in their action of July 6th 1878 so that portion of the road was declared established and the Co. Clerk directed to issue the necessary papers for the opening of the same. The Board agreed to award the claimants for damages the following amounts, subject to the conditions named below

R. A. Dues claim at	\$75.00
S. C. Barricklow	110.00
Grant Sturdy	90.00
J. P. Anderson	10.00

And the Board ordered the road located according to the filed note and Surveyor's Condition that the claimants for damages accept the foregoing amounts in full consideration of damages otherwise the Report of the Viewers and the road reported except that portion established July 6th 1878 & the Co. Clerk is hereby ordered to issue on application the necessary order for the opening of the same

In the matter of Petition for Roads by J. L. McCarroll & others

The report of the Viewers was publicly read which was as follows to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas. In obedience to your order, issued at your July session A.D. 1878 we the undersigned Viewers appointed under said order, met with J. L. Darling, Surveyor at the place appointed on Aug 29 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order. E. Marshall and W. Meacy were selected and sworn as chain carriers and J. Meacy as marker who was also duly sworn. We then proceeded to view and proposed County Road on the line described in your order and cleared the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same, as in your opinion a good road can be made at a
