In the matter of a Petition to vacate
and relocate a certain road by }
Mr. T. Fitzpatrick & others }

as follows to wit To vacate so much
of the road known as the Lawrence & Topeka State road as runs through
or across Section seventeen (17) Township Twelfth (12) Range eighteen (18) and
to Relocate the same

Commencing at the South east corner of the
South east quarter of said Section seventeen (17) thence West on the line of said
quarter to the South west corner; thence angling across the South west quarter
of Section seventeen (17) to intersect the present line of said road at the
west line of the Section; The Board having said petition under considera-
tion and being satisfied that it is signed by at least twelve resident
Householders of Douglas Co. Kansas and a good and sufficient bond having been
filed conditioned for the payment of all the cost of viewers and survey pro-
viding the prorata of the petitioners shall not be granted on the final
hearing and therefore hereby appoint E. A. Coleman, Joseph Harrison and
John Kelly viewers and Collins Whaler Surveyor of said road and command
them to make the viewers Survey and make due report to the next Regular
Sitting of the Board of Commissioners And the County Clerk is hereby
instructed to issue the necessary notices to the viewers & Surveyor and
Cause the lawful publication to be made so as faithfully to carry
out this order of the Board

In the matter of the Report of the
Viewers on the F. B. Hall petition
for the Vacating & Relocation of a road

The report of the viewers appointed
at the July Session was publicly read as follows: In obedience to your
Order issued at your July Session AD 1878. the undersigned viewers appointed
under said order with Mr. C. Darling Deputy Surveyor at the front names
thereon on the 24th instant 1878 and were severally sworn to discharge,
faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order J. P. Hall
and Wm. Young were selected and Sworn as Chairmen and George W. Fair as
Marker. We then proceeded to view said road proposed to be vacated on the line
described in your order and caused the same to be surveyed as prayed for in
the petition or as near thereto as in our opinion was necessary taking
into consideration the utility convenience and inconvenience and expense
which will result to individuals as well as the public by the vacating
of said road as shown by the full note and plot of the Survey we would
respectfully report that the said portion of said road ought to be vacated
