Myself others <sup>State</sup> praying for the change of a certain road which runs from the County line between Marion and Douglas counties easterly across across the South East portion of the North half of Section Twenty three (23) and the North East quarter of Section Twenty four (24), and the South West of the North East quarter of Section Twenty four (24) all of Township (13) Range Thirteen (17) May be changed out the quarter section line so as to run from said County line East on the South line of the North half of Section Twenty three (23) and of the North West of Section Twenty four (24) and the South West of the North East of said Section Twenty four (24) of said Township and thence easterly to intersect the road as it now runs and that the width of said road be changed from 60 feet to 40 feet in width, and whereas said petition was signed by twelve resident households and was accompanied with a good and sufficient bond conditioned for the payment of all the costs of said view & Survey providing at the final hearing the prayer of said petitioners should be granted, the Board having the same under consideration and finding that said petition was in all respects a lawful one do hereby appoint Geo W. Morris and James Brooks viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor under said petition who are hereby instructed to proceed on the 10th day of December to the discharge of the duties therein involved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the necessary papers to carry this Order into effect.
