

In the matter of Report of 33  
 Viewers on Wm. Croft Road The Viewers appointed at the July session  
 1878 on petition of Wm. Croft made report which was publicly  
 read as follows In obedience to your order issued July 1878 the Viewers  
 appointed under said Order met with T. C. Darling Surveyor at  
 the place appointed and were severally sworn to discharge faithfully  
 and impartially the duties required of us in said order Govt. G. Green &  
 H. McCullum were selected and sworn as chain carriers and  
 John Beard as Clerk. We then proceeded to view said proposed County  
 road on the line described in your order or as near the same as  
 in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense ta  
 king into consideration the utility, convenience and convenience  
 and expense, which will result to individual as well as the  
 public by the location of said road, as shown by the Diagrams  
 and plan of the survey accompanying this report.

We would respectfully report that the said Road  
 ought to be established for the following reason Public convenience  
 demands it and a good road can be made along the route  
 Surveyed at a trifling expenditure of Money and Labor it being a geo-  
 natural location for a road. We have also determined that public  
 convenience requires that said road shall be established 6 feet in  
 width. Signed by Wm. Green John P. Garner H. McCullum  
 The Viewers also award Jacob Baker Ten dollars compensation  
 for loss taken by the laying of said road.

The Board having the foregoing report under consideration  
 and there being no objections to its adoption the Board ordered its  
 adoption and the Road established as reported by the Viewers and the Co  
 Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the necessary papers to the proper officer  
 on application for the opening of said road.

In the Matter of Petition 33  
 for the vacation of a certain road  
 from the S. E. corner of the 8th corner of Section 11 of Town Range  
 19 thence East 1790 chains to a stake in line thence following the  
 road established July 1st 1869 on Petition of P. A. Dolbert others to the terminus  
 of said road on the Section line between Sections 8 and 9 of Town  
 12 Range 19 And whereas said petition was signed by twelve resident  
 householders and was accompanied with bond conditions for the pay  
 ment of the costs of said Survey of vacation. Therefore the Board does  
 hereby appoint Charles Garrison, W. A. Rankin and D. L. Reece to view  
 the vacation sought for and to make due report to them at the next Regular  
 session of the Board and the Co Clerk is hereby instructed to issue the papers  
 necessary to carry the foregoing order into effect. The Viewers named
