And we would respectfully report that said road ought to be vacated for the following reasons: Public Convenience does not require its continuance and it is a great inconvenience to the property of private individuals. There being no objections made by anyone to the foregoing report the Board adopted it and ordered the road vacated and instructed the County Clerk to issue the necessary papers to carry this order into effect.
