

(over) voted to the Lawrence & South Western Railroad Company and \$30,000
voted to the Lawrence & Lawrence & Galveston Railroad Company and
bearing date January 1st 1868 all of these said bonds bearing interest at the
rate of seven per cent per annum.

And be it further resolved that the Sheriff of Douglas County
make proclamation of the time and place for holding said election
and that the County Clerk of said County be, and he is hereby instructed and
authorized to procure the publications of these resolutions according to
law stating time and place of holding said election with a statement of
the particular indebtedness proposed to be satisfied by the issue of said
new bonds and the amount necessary to satisfy the same, and also the
time when the bonds proposed to be issued shall be payable and the rate of
interest they are to bear said publication to make their next
preceding said election.

In the matter of appropriating \$45,000 to build certain Bridges The Board having the same under con-
sideration the following resolution and order were adopted

Resolved that at the next general election to be held in Douglas Co
on the 5th day of November 1879 the question shall be submitted
to the electors of said County whether the Board of Commissioners
of said County shall be authorized to levy a tax for the purpose of appropri-
ating funds to the amount of \$45,000 and for the purposes following To wit
Twenty thousand (\$20,000) to build three iron bridges across the Wakarusa
Creek at the following place to wit One at Eudora One at New Johnson
crossing One at Rock Ford One at Sigel and one at Belvoir and Twenty five
thousand dollars \$25,000 to build an iron bridge across mud creek in said
County at the point known as Robinsons crossing and to buy or build a
bridge across the Kansas river at Lawrence the form of ballots to be used shall
be as follows. Those in favor of the proposition shall read For the propo-
sition to levy a tax to build bridges and those against the proposition shall read
Against the proposition to levy a tax to build bridges

And it is hereby further ordered that the County Clerk shall cause the
foregoing resolution to be published in the Kansas Tribune for fifteen days
prior to said election.
