The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas met in the office of the County Clerk in Special Session for the purpose of taking account of Redemption Certificates and to examine and approve the Official Bond of J. E. Watson Treasurer of Douglas Co. if presented. This being the last day under the law for filing the same.

The meeting was called by John Sestine, the Chairman of the Board and there were present John C. Walton, Ex. Sestine, B. F. Digg, Co. Clerk

There being no Redemption Certificates presented for examination and Mr. Watson failing to file his Official bond as Treasurer of Douglas Co. The Board adjourned until to-morrow morning nine o'clock A.M. Attest B. F. Digg, Co. Clerk

Lawrence, Douglas Co. Kansas October 30th A. D. 1878.
