

to the vacancy in the Treasurers office as follows
 To the Hon Board of County Commissioners of Douglas,
 Gentlemen

Answering your question whether there now
 is a vacancy in the office of County Treasurer which it is your
 duty to fill by appointment. I will say that I have examined
 the Statute and made inquiry regarding the facts of the case
 and am of the opinion that the resignation of Mr Watson
 of his first term ending on the second Tuesday of October and the
 appointment of Mr Morrison to fill the vacancy, so called did not
 effect Mr Watson's title to the office for the term for which he
 was elected last commencing on the second Tuesday of October
 last. Mr Watson was then legally entitled to the office provided
 it did not become vacant by virtue of the existence of some
 one of the events mentioned in section 1243 Dassler's Statute.
 None of those events have happened except the 28th. This could
 not happen until 90 days from the said second Tuesday of Octo-
 ber or until 28th day of October. There was ^{then} no vacancy in the
 office until said last mentioned day Dassler sec 1237
 But the failure of Mr Watson to file his bond and oath of office
 on or before Oct 28th has made a vacancy which it is the duty
 of the Board to fill by appointment Dassler 1063 which
 appointment will hold good until the next General
 election and the qualification of the successor to be then
 elected 8 Kans 333 13 Kans 367

 within the ten day necessary to be given in case of a special
 election preceding the general election to be held on Nov 5 I do
 not think it can be legally filled by election at that time but
 am of the opinion that your appointee will hold the office
 until the next General election to be held after Nov 5 1878
