

not occur until the 29th day of October preceding the time at which the Election came off, and that no official notification was made by the Sheriff or Commissioners that such vacancy existed, and whereas - the present incumbent expressed a willingness to turn over his office to such person as the Commissioners may appoint, therefore -

Resolved - That in order to avoid legal complications we will proceed to appoint a Treasurer to fill the vacancy occasioned by the failure of James E. Watson to qualify - Commissioner John C. Walton seconded the motion to adopt the resolution. The Chairman of the Board put the question - Shall the resolution pass? The vote being taken, John Walton and John C. Walton voted "Y" and John Derkines voted no, and the resolution was declared adopted -

John C. Walton moved that the Board proceed to vote for a person to fill the vacancy in the Treasurer's Office according ^{to} the foregoing resolution, which motion was seconded by John Walton.

The Chairman put the question and the vote being taken John Walton and John C. Walton voted "Y" and John Derkines voted no, so the motion was declared carried and the Board proceeded to Ballot for County Treasurer.

On the first ballot, Oliver Barber received one vote and two votes were cast blank.

On the second ballot Oliver Barber received one vote Dr. Derkines one vote and one blank vote

On the third ballot Oliver Barber received one vote

Polar received one vote and Gould received one vote

On the 4th ballot Oliver Barber received one vote William Rae received one vote and one blank vote

The Board then adjourned 'till tomorrow morning at 9 O'clock A.M.
