Mr. John C. Walton introduced the
 following resolution, and moved that it be adopted -
 Whereas there is a question raised by certain parties as
 to the legality of Mr. Oliver Barber's Election as Treasurer
 of Douglas County at the recent Election -
 Therefore. Resolved - that it will serve the interests
 of Douglas County to appoint Mr. Barber Treasurer of
 Douglas County, thereby indorsing the vote of the people
 of Douglas County.

Commissioner John Walton seconded the motion to adopt
 the resolution. A vote being taken, Commissioners
 John Derkines and John Walton voted "No" and J. C. Walton
 voted "Yes" and so the motion was lost.

No other business coming before the Board, the Board
 adjourned until tomorrow morning at 10 O'clock A.M.
